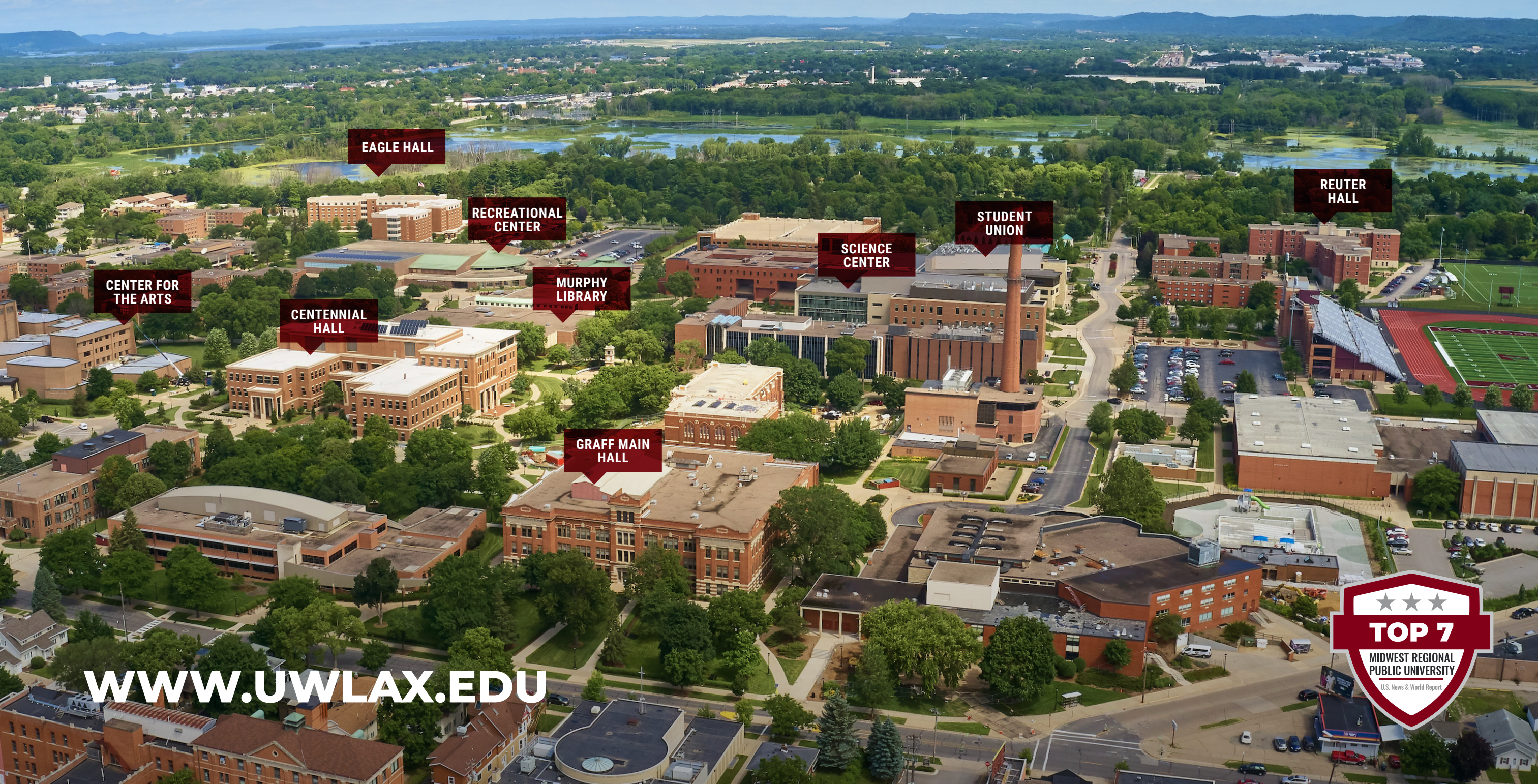

TRAVEL BEYOND LA CROSSE

CAR If students do not have a car and need a ride, they can check the Facebook virtual rideshare groups. Students who have cars and would like riders to share expenses will post their destination there.

TRAIN Amtrak serves La Crosse with daily service to Minneapolis and Chicago on the Empire Builder.

BUS Jefferson Lines provides transportation to 14 states across America's Heartland with affordable prices and convenient schedules. Badger Bus provides transportation from Minneapolis to Milwaukee, with a stop at UW-La Crosse.

AIR Located 10 km from campus, the La Crosse Regional Airport (LSE) has daily flights on Delta and American Airlines between Minneapolis/St. Paul and Chicago.
