

**What to do next?**

- Accept or decline your financial aid offer via your WINGS Student Center.
  - The amount accepted will be disbursed in two parts (Fall & Spring).
  - "Your Other Loan Eligibility\*" is for information only and can't be accepted.
- If you are offered Federal Work-Study, you will be emailed a link to a questionnaire which will help us find a work placement for you on campus.
- If you are accepting your First Federal Direct Loan, you will need to complete Entrance Loan Counseling and a Master Promissory Note. Both can be completed at [studentaid.gov](http://studentaid.gov).
- If you wish for the Financial Aid Office to be able to discuss your information with your parents or others, you will need to set up a FERPA SECURE PIN at [uwlax.edu/records/ferpa](http://uwlax.edu/records/ferpa).
- If you are receiving scholarships, be sure to report those awards in WINGS.
- Refunds can be deposited directly into your personal bank account. Set up your refund preference in the Finances section of your UWL WINGS Student Center, choose 'Student Choice Refund'.

**Disbursement of Financial Aid**

All financial aid (except Federal Work-Study) is electronically credited to your university bill, generally on the first day of each semester if all documents have been completed.

**Additional Requirements**

All financial aid is offered based on full-time attendance. If you are less than full-time, you may see an adjustment to your financial aid.
