(DAILY WORK WEAR)

LOW KEY SHOES

like flats, low heels and nice boots are acceptable.





BUSINESS CASUAL COLORS AND STYLES:

NICE PANTS/SLACKS

DRESSES

NO JEANS, SHORTS, SUNDRESSES OR ATHLETIC WEAR



BLAZERS & CARDIGANS are another good option.

JSINESS PROFESSIONA.

(INTERVIEWING FOR JOBS OR INTERNSHIPS)



CLOTHES SHOULD BE:

SOLID, DARK OR **NEUTRAL COLORS**

LIGHT COLORS CAN BE WORN UNDERNEATH

SHOES SHOULD BE:

CLOSED-TOE HEEL OR DRESS SHOES

SUIT JACKET & PANTS/SKIRT

should be matching colors.

PERSONAL ITEMS & CELL PHONES Keep cellphones turned off and out of sight with personal items.





BRING ESSENTIALS ONLY!

Carry a portfolio, professional bag or simple purse.
