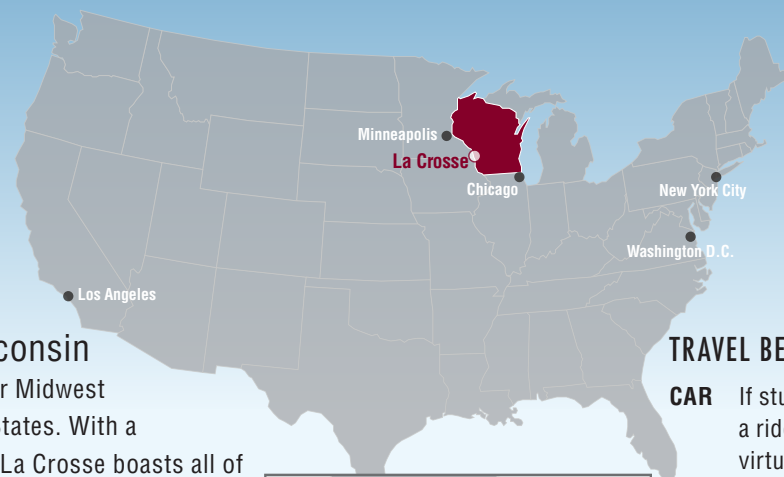

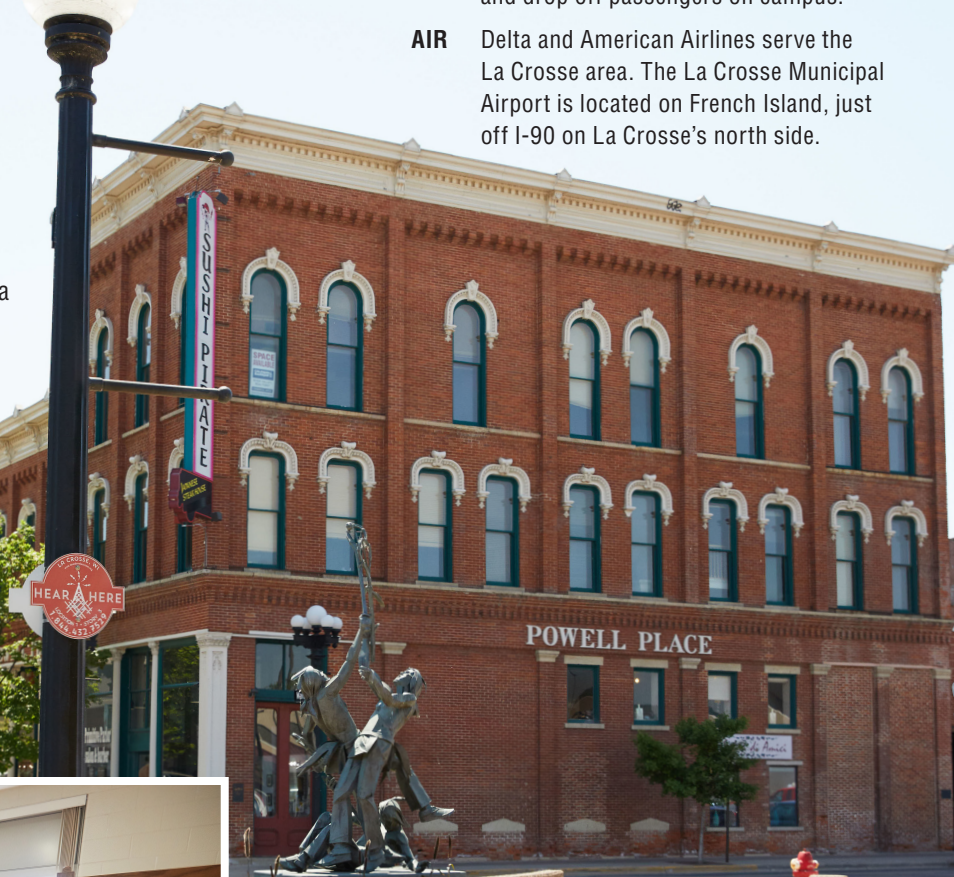
TRAVEL BEYOND LA CROSSE

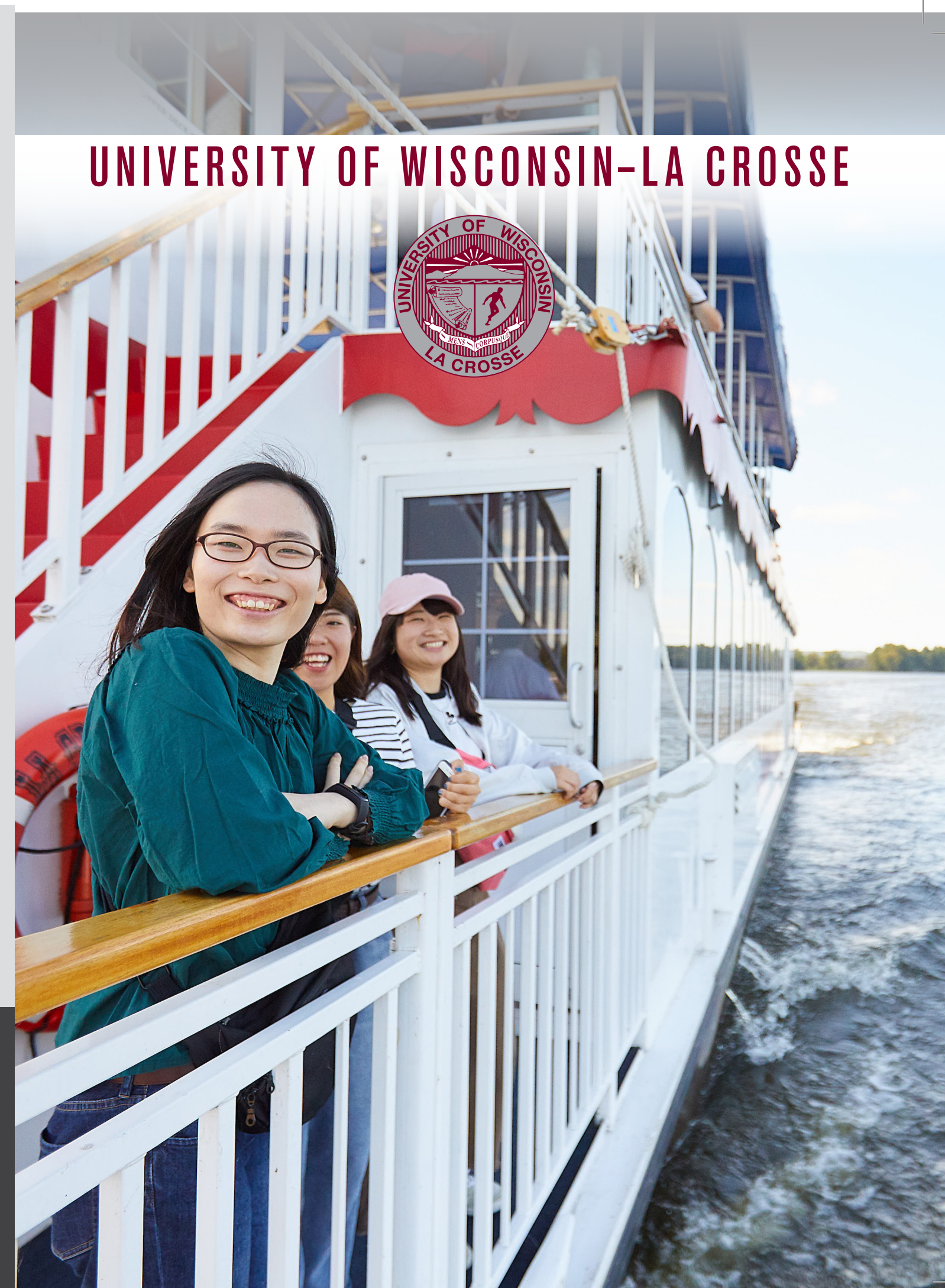
