Senate Update: **Referendum for Academic Initiatives, VOTE ON WEDNESDAY 11/18**. Voting on two things, first question is if you want to continue to fund the programs available through the Academic Initiatives, if vote yes, programs will continue, fees will increase from \$60/year to \$105/year. Second question is voting to expand and enhance the programs offered now, a yes vote would be saying that you'd be willing to increase the fee by no more than \$15, therefore the total student fee would be no more than \$120.
