Dear Dr. Nelson:

On January 29, 2005 the CSAH College Committee unanimously recommended (7/0/0) approval of the proposed Computer Science/WWTC 2+2 Agreement that includes a partial waiver of the SAH College core curriculum. In particular, the Committee approved a waiver from requiring either a minor from any college or 18 credits at the 300 or 400 level in courses outside the major department from any college. The Committee recognizes the difficulty for students pursuing this degree program; having only ten elective credits at the 300 or 400 level, three of which have to be used for general education requirements.

The College Committee did request that only four of the ten elective credits at the 300 or 400 level be satisfied by internship credits. The SAH College Committee recognizes the positive impact in pursuing this type of agreement with the Technical Colleges but would also like to point out that this waiver was granted for this particular degree option and any future programs with similar requests should be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
