We also need the following *additional* materials from juniors – verification of ACT registration; from seniors - college letters, verification of completed FAFSA. Stipends for 3/19 - 5/4 will be distributed during the week of 5/14. **Before you can receive your spring stipend, we need:** from all: paperwork due from first semester, summer paperwork, evaluation of semester. We also need the following *additional* materials from juniors - PSAT scores, attendance at ACT prep, confirm ACT registration; and from seniors - college letters, ACT scores, FAFSA completed, SAR copy, financial aid proposal(s).
