REQUIRED: 48 credits including ART **160***, 162, 164, 166, 251, 252, and 262 (core curriculum); and one elective from 331, 332 and 341; three courses to be elected from ART 204, 205, 207, 214, 216, 218, 220, 221, and APH 202; and four courses to be elected from 303, 304, 305, 308, 314, 316, 318, 320, 321, 362, 405, 408, 413, 414, 416, 418, 419, 421, 425, and 462. ART 399 is required to be taken in the junior year. ART 499 is required to be taken in the senior year.
