Students choose courses relevant to one of three areas of concentration : evolutionary biology, organismic biology (eg. botany, zoology, fisheries), or cell biology. Doctoral Programs: The Interdisciplinary Doctoral Program in Biological Sciences (IDPBS) has Experimental Biology as its primary focus. This concentration is designed to provide interdisciplinary doctoral training in molecular genetics, systematics, and evolution, cellular biology, biochemistry, ecology, and physiology. Students in this program will receive broad exposure to topics that range across all the life sciences disciplines. The curriculum emphasizes the study of biological processes at the molecular, cellular, organismal, and community levels. Students can conduct research in a variety of fields guided by expert faculty.

Coastal Resources Management Program (CRM)

The Biology Department participates with Departments of Geological Sciences, Geography, Sociology, and Political Science in this interdisciplinary program.
