****INTERNET (ONLINE) COURSES-**For all Internet (online) courses, an additional \$75 per credit internet course fee is charged. This is in addition to the regular tuition fees listed above.

This amount will be automatically charged along with standard tuition rates and will help support the development of additional online educational opportunities at UW-L.

This fee is not added to the special rates associated with the online programs of SAA and Dosimetry.

OVER 12 UNDERGRADUATE CREDITS: WI Residents add \$267.69 per credit, MN Residents add \$280.64 per credit, Non-residents add \$583.23 per credit.

MINNESOTA RECIPROCIITY

It is the student's responsibility to apply for the Reciprocity Agreement. Those who do not apply, or who apply late and/or are not approved, will be required to pay non-resident rates. Application forms are available online at www.ohe.state.mn.us.

SPECIAL COURSE FEES: Students may be assessed fees for supplemental materials, equipment, lab manuals or field trips for certain courses. Please consult the cashiers office website www.uwlax.edu/cashiers and click on Special Course Fees link on the left to view these fees

GRADUATION FEE: \$15.00 undergraduate and graduate. On completion of 95 semester hours towards a bachelor's degree or 20 credit hours towards a master's, students are billed the graduation fee.

This one-time fee must be paid at the time it is billed, whether or not the student is graduating that semester. The fee covers the cost of the diploma, cover and expenses of the commencement ceremony. All students must pay the fee whether or not they participate in the ceremony.

CHECKS RETURNED FOR INSUFFICIENT FUNDS: \$20.00 handling charge will be added to the student's account.

UNITED STATES STUDENT ASSOCIATION FEE: \$0.25. These fees are assessed to all students. Call 608 785-8888 for further information.

CAREER SERVICES FEE: \$6.50. Fee is assessed to all undergraduate students each semester. Call 608 785-8514 for further information.

AUDIT POLICY: Non-degree students who register for AUDIT ONLY. WI Residents & MN Residents with reciprocity pay 30% of credit fee. Non-residents pay 50% of credit fee.

The audit fee doesn't apply to students taking classes for course credit or seeking degrees. They pay the credit fee from the Fee Schedule. Audits are allowed, as space is available & require instructor's approval. Wisconsin residents age 60 or older (as of the first day of classes) are not assessed audit fees for audit-type attendance of credit classes. Disabled Wisconsin residents who present evidence of receiving disability insurance benefits under either the federal Supplemental Security Income (SSI) program or the federal Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) program and who are enrolled exclusively for audit throughout the term are not assessed audit fees. Audit students are required to pay Special Course fees in full even if they are not assessed audit fees.

EXCESS CREDIT POLICY: Wisconsin resident undergraduate students who have earned 165 credits (or 30 credits more than required by their degree programs, whichever is greater)

will be charged a surcharge, equal to 100 percent of the regular resident tuition, on credits beyond that level. Students with questions or concerns about this policy should contact their dean's office.

Current Students: Using a student identification number and password, students can update their address, display class schedule and grades, view current semester fees and bills, obtain personal tax reporting information, and pay their tuition electronically by e-check or credit/debit card.
