

# General Fee Information

This fee schedule covers courses beginning after the spring semester.

1. Fees are assessed according to student classification. Students who are classified as graduate students will be assessed graduate fees for all courses taken.
2. There is a \$100 Advance Registration Deposit required for summer session. Students will be allowed to register after all previous semesters balances have been paid in full and the Advanced Registration Deposit has also been paid.

**ELECTRONIC BILLING SCHEDULE:**

Tuition bills are emailed to the student's **University email address**. Current billing detail can also be viewed on-line through WINGS.

**Note:** All balances past 30 days will be assessed a 1% per month service charge. Students can pay their tuition bill online through WINGS by e-check or credit/debit card. There is a 2.75% convenience fee for all credit/debit card transactions. MasterCard, Discover, American Express and Diners Club are accepted. VISA is not accepted because of convenience fee structure. There is NO FEE for e-check transactions. You can also pay by cash/check at the Cashier's Office-121 Graff Main Hall or by mail.

3. Financial aid will be available beginning Monday, May 23, 2011.

**Adjustment Schedule for Withdrawals and Credit Drops:** The following schedule shows the percentage of adjustment for withdrawal from the University and for credit drops. The amount of adjustment is determined by the date of the withdrawal or credit drop on file in the Records & Registration Office. Withdrawal forms are available in the Student Life Office, 149 Graff Main Hall. There are no refunds or adjustments of special course fees after the 100 percent adjustment period.

**NOTE:** UW-La Crosse is responsible for complying with federal regulations governing participation in the student financial assistance programs authorized under Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 as amended. To the extent that these regulations require a larger return of funds to federal funding sources than the amount specified by the adjustment policy stipulated below, the student will be responsible for the difference.
