

2008 Mark Anthony Scholarship Application

The University of Wisconsin-La Crosse sponsored Mark Anthony Scholarship is named in honor of one of the clown world's greatest contributors. Mark Anthony performed throughout the world in circuses large and small. He was a master prop builder and a very unique clown. Attesting to his greatness is the fact that he was one of the first inductees into the International Clown Hall of Fame.

The University of Wisconsin-La Crosse Foundation established this memorial scholarship fund in 1990. Donations from Clown Camp® participants, staff members and friends have provided the fund's principle to perpetuate this program. At least fifteen \$250 scholarships will be awarded in 2008.

There are three applicant categories from which scholarships will be awarded: .

- At least one award to a registrant under the age of 19
- At least one award to a police officer, fire fighter or paramedic
- At least two awards to overseas participants, in the amount of \$450

Applicants for any of the above scholarships must be registrants at the time of their application submission. There are no specific skills or levels of experience necessary to qualify for an award. Only persons who have won a Mark Anthony scholarship in the past three years are ineligible.
