### Applications

In this packet you will find an application form and a copy of our Terms and Conditions. In order to register for the trip, you should complete by **December 15, 2008** the application and return it with a check for \$500 per person, made payable to the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse, to Janice Olson in the Office of Continuing Education, University of Wisconsin-La Crosse, 1725 State Street, 205 Morris Hall, La Crosse, WI 54601. When sending in your application and deposit, please also include a legible photocopy of the first two pages of your passport, which reflects your signature, photograph and general passport information. **Please note that the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse can accept a credit card, check or cash for payment of the deposit or any other payment. Distant Horizons can ONLY accept payment for additional land and air arrangements in the form of a check, money order or cashier's check and payment by credit card is not possible.**

### Required Documents for United States Citizens

Your passport must be valid for at least six (6) months past the last day of your planned trip. Therefore, if a trip you are considering returns to the United States on January 20, your passport must be valid until July 20.

A visa is required for entry into Brazil. Detailed information regarding the specific visa requirements and instructions for obtaining this visa will be sent to you by Distant Horizons approximately two months prior to your departure date.

### Recommended Immunizations

Very few countries actually require immunizations these days. However, there are a number of recommended immunizations for Argentina, Brazil and Chile. We will send you further information on this about two months before your departure date. In addition, we do recommend that you check with your personal physician or contact the Center for Disease Control and Prevention in Atlanta at (404) 639-3311 or [www.cdc.gov/travel/](http://www.cdc.gov/travel/).

### Cancellation

**It is very important** that you read the trip cancellation clause in our Terms and Conditions carefully and make sure that you understand it, **as it will be strictly adhered to.** Please call us if you have any questions. **All requests to cancel must be received in writing and dated accordingly. The date on your cancellation letter will determine the time period your refund will fall under, NOT the date you call us.**
