

Computer-Based Testing (CBT)

The UW-L Computer-Based Testing (CBT) Center is an official testing center for Educational Testing Service. Our testing center lab is comprised of five computer work stations that are nationally networked and technically supported by Prometric in Princeton, NJ. We administer all of the high stakes exams described in this brochure. To register for an exam, call the Center at (608) 785-8968.

CBT HOURS

CBT hours are Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, & Friday: 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. from September 1- June 1. Call for specific summer hours.

VALID IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED!

- No identification means no test! It is very important to check the identification requirements for each test. If you are not clear what identification to bring, contact our office.

DIRECTIONS TO UW-LA CROSSE

- From the East: West on I-90; exit at Highway 16 (Exit 5). Turn left on Highway 16 and then right on La Crosse Street to campus.
- From the West: East on I-90; exit at Highway 157 (Exit 4) and turn right. Take Highway 157 to Highway 16. Turn right on Hwy 16 and right on La Crosse Street to campus.
- From the North: Highway 61 on the Minnesota side of the Mississippi and Hwy 35 on the Wisconsin side join I-90 to Highway 157 (Exit 4). Follow directions from the west.
- From the South: Highways 14, 61, and 35 enter the city on the south. Follow the green "UW-La Crosse" signs north on Losey Boulevard to Hwy 16. Turn left on La Crosse Street to campus.

NOTE:	There are cancellation and rescheduling fees.



iBT TOEFL – TEST OF ENGLISH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE

The TOEFL is designed to measure the ability of nonnative speakers to use and understand English. The test measures English language in the following areas: listening, structure, reading, and writing.

PPST – PRE-PROFESSIONAL SKILLS TEST (PRAXIS SERIES)

The PPST, part of the Praxis Series, consists of three tests; reading, math, and writing. These exams are required for admission into education programs and for teacher certification in many states.

Retest policy:	An examinee may take each Praxis CBT test once per calendar month up to 6 times in a 12 month period.
Identification:	US Citizen: passport or US driver's license Non-US Citizen: passport

MCAT – MEDICAL COLLEGE ADMISSION TEST

The MCAT is an admission requirement for most medical schools.

Appointment Length:	5.5 hours
Test fees:	\$225 (VISA, MasterCard, American Express)
Retest policy:	You may take the MCAT a maximum of 3 times per year, but can only register for one testing session at a time.
Requirements:	Any form of a current, valid government-issued identification containing your photo, signature, and an expiration date. Typically, examinees bring their driver's license or passport.
NOTE:	There are cancellation and rescheduling fees.
