True or False?

1. Young women who **do not smoke** and **who use the pill** (modern low dosage oral contraceptives) **will live longer**, on average, than other young women who do not smoke and who use no form of fertility control.
2. There is a type of “unprotected sexual intercourse” (condoms are not used) that substantially **increases the likelihood of transmitting AIDS** more so than others.
3. The **number of people** in the United States who **die from AIDS** has **increased each year since 1994**.
4. Women who have vaginal sex with AIDS infected men are **more likely to acquire HIV disease** than are men to acquire this disease after having the same type of sex with AIDS infected women.
5. The approximate odds of a sexually active twenty year-old woman becoming pregnant over the course of one year while **using no fertility control** is about **80 percent**.
6. The one day that a woman is *most likely* to become pregnant if she has sex on that day is the seventh day after her menstrual period begins.
7. On average, the mature woman releases **one ovum only approximately every 28 days** despite the fact that she has two ovaries.
8. At present there are **no known cures** for AIDS, Hepatitis B, Genital Herpes, and Genital Warts (Human Papilloma Virus).
9. The average male ejaculate contains approximately **one million spermatozoa**.
10. Supposing that a woman has ovulated a few days prior to sexual intercourse occurring, the number of spermatozoa that are likely to reach her ovum from a single male ejaculate is **about 5,000**.
