New Business:

- Elections Update Bob Wilson and Josh Kraft reported that the online elections for CSC positions has been set up and will be sent out to all Classified Staff very soon.
- Classified Living Wage Proposal Numerous guests were present for a short discussion on raising the starting wage for the lowest paying positions. Concerns were expressed about starting wages not being increased for all positions and how this proposal would lower morale of staff not receiving any increase in pay. Guests were invited to attend our next scheduled meeting on May 14, 2013 when Bob Hetzel will be providing additional information on this topic.
- Tobacco Free Campus Presentation Three students working for the UW-L Wellness Coordinator, Jason Bertrand, provided a PowerPoint and answered questions regarding UW-L becoming a tobacco-free campus. The tobacco-free policy proposal would begin on July 1, 2013. This initiative was funded with a grant provided by Spark. Cessation assistance would be provided for individuals that would like to end their use of tobacco products. Enforcement of the policy will mainly be done through self-compliance. Violations will be handled like other work rules or policy violations.
- Motion was made by Tim Miller with a 2nd from Jeff Berger to vote on the Tobacco-Free Campus Policy. Those in favor of implementing the policy were asked to respond with a yes vote. CSC voted unanimously against implementation of the Tobacco-Free Campus Policy.
