Academic Dress

The academic apparel worn by faculty and staff in the processional has its origins in the universities of the Middle Ages. Because the universities grew out of church schools, both faculty and students were regarded as part of the clergy, and wore clerical clothing based on monastic dress.

The head covering developed from the skull cap worn to protect tonsured heads in cold weather. In the universities, the skull cap acquired a point at the top which gradually evolved into a tassel. In Europe, the bonnet with a tassel is still worn, but has been replaced in America by the mortar board cap or tam with a tassel.

The style of the gown may have been borrowed from the Benedictine monk's habit. In the Middle Ages, those with bachelor's and master's degrees could be distinguished by the simplicity or elaborateness of their gowns. The master's gowns were often furred, a decoration surviving as the three velvet bars now used on the sleeves of the doctoral gown.

The hood was originally worn over the head in bad weather, and otherwise dropped onto the shoulders. First worn by faculty and students, the hood is now added to the apparel of those with master's and doctoral degrees. The color of the velvet trim on the hood indicates the scholarly field, for example, dark blue (philosophy), golden yellow (science), light blue (education), pink (music), apricot (nursing), drab (business), and white (arts). The colors of the satin lining are those approved and authorized by the college or university from which the degree was earned.

Scholarship Pins

Students who received a scholarship from the UWL Foundation during their time at UWL are wearing pins on their gowns.

Medallion Symbolizes Academic Excellence

Wearing a medallion or seal of office has been a symbol of academic excellence since the Middle Ages.

The seal marked official documents then; heads of institutions wore the seal around the neck to keep it in their possession. The chancellor's medallion features a design and materials that reflect UW-La Crosse.

The mokume-gane or "wood grain metal" used is a specialty of the campus jewelry studio.

Mace Shows Quest for Truth

Once a weapon in medieval combat, the mace was adopted by universities as a symbol of the power of the quest for truth. The mace is carried in the commencement ceremony by a distinguished senior faculty member. William R. Fiorini, a UWL art professor, designed and made the medallion and mace, which were used for the first time at the inauguration of Chancellor Judith L. Kuipers in September 1992.

The mace and medallion were given to the University by Mary Heberd and Ruth Nixon-Davy, professors emeriti. Silver plaques on the medallion box and mace stand acknowledge these gifts.

Symbols of Academic Achievement

Many undergraduate students are wearing items that reflect high academic achievement. Commencement Honors are designated by silver cords, and are worn by students who have at least a 3.50 cumulative grade point average. Those wearing gold cords have earned Commencement Highest Honors with at least a 3.75 average. Members of the Golden Key International Honour Society are wearing a medallion on a blue and gold neck ribbon. The organization is open to the top 15 percent of graduating seniors in various fields of study. Discipline-specific honor organizations are represented by a variety of other cords.

International Flags and Sashes

The international flags displayed on the commencement platform represent the home countries of international students attending the University. Sashes are worn by graduates who studied abroad. Each sash represents the country in which the student studied.

Even more reasons to be a proud UW-La Crosse graduate ...

- **U.S. News & World Report has promoted UWL to its “Top Public Schools Among National Universities.”** The 2023 rank lists UWL the No. 1 public university in Wisconsin with less than 25,000 students. The magazine also lists UWL among “Top Performers on Social Mobility,” identifying schools successfully assisting students from low-income families through college to graduation.
- **UWL is the only comprehensive UW campus to crack a new list of the nation’s best public colleges.** UWL placed No. 100 in Stacker.com, a new ranking by news provider Stacker — the only Wisconsin university besides UW-Madison to make the list. The ranking evaluated academics, admissions, cost and student life. • Financial and business news website Business Insider says when it comes to giving students the most bang for their buck, UWL is among the best nationally. With a 69.7% ROI, UWL placed 20th out of the 24 colleges that cracked the list — the only Wisconsin university ranked.
- **UWL welcomed its largest first-year class to campus in fall 2022** — 2,308, topping the 2,207 in fall 2021.
- **The UWL men’s and women’s indoor track and field teams won the NCAA III championships** in March. It was the first time in D-III history that one university swept both titles. The two national titles mean UWL has a combined 73 championships. UWL will host the 2024 NCAA III Wrestling Championships and the 2026 NCAA III Women’s and Men’s Outdoor Track & Field Championships.
- **In October 2022, the Center for the Arts was dedicated as the Truman T. Lowe Center for the Arts**, honoring the late Ho-Chunk artist alum. The first UWL building named after a person of color, it promises to inspire current and future Native American students to pursue their passions.
- **La Crosse is the best small college town in Wisconsin and among the best in the country**, according to PrepLy, an online language learning company. Its list of the best small college towns in the U.S. has La Crosse at No. 4 — the only Wisconsin city to crack the top 10.
- **And, La Crosse is the state’s most wallet-friendly and among the most economical college towns in the U.S.** Scholarship and grant search engine BrokeScholar.com ranks La Crosse the No. 11 most economical college town in the U.S. and the No. 1 most economical place in Wisconsin for students to study.
- **UWL’s Community Engaged Learning Program received the 2022 AASCU Excellence & Innovation Award for Civic Learning and Community Engagement.** The American Association of State Colleges and Universities award cites the outstanding results and potential of a program to influence and serve as a model for other institutions.
- **UWL received the 2021 Campus-Wide Award for Undergraduate Research Accomplishments.** The national Council on Undergraduate Research citation recognizes campuses providing high-quality research experiences to undergraduates.
- **Students get their money’s worth at UWL according to a new ranking by finance technology company SmartAsset.** In the company’s list of best value colleges, UWL placed No. 4 in Wisconsin and No. 50 in the U.S., underscoring UWL’s commitment to affordability, high-quality academic programming and providing students with a strong return on their investment.

- **UWL’s ROTC Eagle Battalion is the Best ROTC Battalion in the Midwest’s 3rd Brigade.** The 2022 MacArthur Award is for the region that includes 42 military science programs in all sizes of colleges in Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota and Wisconsin.
- **UWL is one of the most military friendly schools in the country.** The 2023-24 Military Friendly Schools survey gave UWL the distinguished gold designation.
- **A new partnership means full steam ahead for the UWL River Studies Center and water research.** Prairie Springs: The Paul Fleckenstein Trust gave nearly \$500,000 through the La Crosse Community Foundation to fund the new research vessel. Local construction, environmental services and harbor management company J.F. Brennan Co. will store, moor and maintain the watercraft.
- **UWL Physics Professor Seth King was named the 2022 Carl E. Gulbrandsen Innovator of the Year by WiSys**, a state nonprofit organization that works with the UW System. The award is given to UW System faculty, staff or students who make exemplary contributions as a WiSys innovator.
- **UWL Department of Sociology and Criminal Justice Associate Professor Dawn Norris has been named a Fulbright Scholar.** She will travel overseas in spring 2023 to study job impacts in the Czech Republic.
- **UWL is No. 1 in awarding physics bachelor’s degrees nationwide**, according to the American Physical Society. UWL awarded an average of 35 degrees annually between 2015-17, making it No. 1 among bachelor’s degree-granting institutions.
- **UWL has received national attention for some of its more than 20 graduate degree programs.** U.S. News & World Report has recognized four graduate programs in the top 100 of their disciplines, including: the UW MBA Consortium, No. 9; UWL’s Physician Assistant program, No. 15; UWL’s Doctorate of Physical Therapy program, No. 42; and UWL’s Professional Studies in Education, No. 52.
- **UWL’s Vice Chancellor for Diversity and Inclusion Barbara Stewart received a 2022 UW System Board of Regents Diversity Award** before she retired later in the year. The honor recognizes a change agent who has significantly promoted equity in educational outcomes for historically underrepresented students.
- **UWL is one of only 230 campuses in 37 states and the District of Columbia designated as a “Voter Friendly Campus.”** Voter Friendly Campuses help students overcome barriers to voting.
- **The National Committee of the Kennedy Center American College Theatre Festival honored the Department of Theatre & Dance** in 2022 with several awards for the original documentary drama, “Severe Clear: September 11 from Memory to History.” Written by UWL faculty and students, the production premiered on campus in Toland Theatre in October 2021.

2023 Outstanding Graduates

The Murphy Awards for Academic Excellence

recognizes the university's top graduating scholar, as chosen by the Scholarship and Awards Committee. A Murphy Foundation grant created the award in 1980 to recognize outstanding and exceptional scholastic ability.

Kaitlyn Michalek graduates with a Bachelor of Science majoring in biology with a biomedical science concentration and pre-dentistry track. She has minors in chemistry and Spanish. Michalek competed on the women's swim and dive team for four semesters and participated in badminton, tennis and bag toss in intramurals. She was the women's intramurals doubles badminton champion in October 2022. Michalek served as vice president and president of the UWL Pre-Dentistry Club. She attended a volunteer dental mission trip to Guatemala to work alongside a bilingual dentist to provide free dental care and education to underserved communities. Michalek has been a Spanish conversation partner, a chemistry tutor and a teaching assistant for human anatomy and physiology. She has volunteered in the community at Hintgen Elementary School, served meals for homeless families and supervised children at the warming center. Michalek plans to attend Marquette University School of Dentistry and hopes to work as a general dentist in a rural setting. She is from Waukesha, Wisconsin.

The Rosandich Graduate Thesis and Dissertation Award

recognizes the best graduate thesis, based on originality, impact and writing quality. The award is funded by Thomas P. Rosandich, '54, founding president of the U.S. Sports Academy in Daphne, Alabama.

Thomas Roehl, who earned a master's degree in biology in December 2022, received the award for his master's thesis, "Examining the genetics of mushroom development in the cultivated edible mushroom *Flammulina velutipes*." Roehl's project involved growing his study organisms and sampling tissues from specific parts of the mushroom (cap, stem, and gills) during its stages of growth from a primordial cell mass to a mature mushroom. From these tissues, Roehl extracted RNA, the genetic material produced when a gene is activated in the cell. By obtaining the sequences of the RNA and comparing between tissues and timepoints, Roehl deciphered the pattern of genes that are turned "on" or "off" during different parts of development. His work provided

the most comprehensive picture of the developmental genetics of *Flammulina velutipes* generated to date. He is currently a doctoral student at Clark University.

Joseph A. Quintana, who earned his Ed.D. in Student Affairs Administration and Leadership (SAAL) in May 2022, received the award for his dissertation, "Adult Online Learners and Their Learning Spaces: A Phenomenological Inquiry." The SAA Department voted unanimously to nominate Quintana's dissertation for the award. Combining his work in online education through UW's Extended Campus and his background in geography, Quintana used concepts and language from the field of geography to examine and understand how adult online learners experienced learning spaces. He argued that his study supported students' space-related practices by helping them assess their needs and make good decisions about their learning spaces. Further, his research helped colleges and universities better consider the needs of online learners and develop structures to meet those needs.

The Jake and Janet Hoeschler Award for Excellence

recognizes a College of Business Administration graduate for academic accomplishment and leadership on campus and in the community. Janet Hoeschler, a 1940 graduate, established the award in 1992 to signify a business-university partnership.

Julia Lewis graduates with a Bachelor of Science, majoring in international business and minoring in Spanish. Lewis earned numerous credits studying in Prague, Czech Republic. She served as a scholarship researcher on campus for nearly three years and worked with Residence Life as a resident assistant and senior resident assistant. Lewis was a member of the Latin American Student Organization, Beta Gamma Sigma and the International Student Organization. She also volunteered as a Spanish conversation partner on campus. Lewis was a communications intern with the UWL Student Research, Creativity and Experiential Learning Office, as well as with River Bank. She received numerous scholarships, including the Joe Laux Family CBA Top Scholar Award. Lewis received an Academic Advising Center & Career Services Certificate of Recognition for outstanding achievement during an internship experience in spring 2023. She plans to attend graduate school and work in international marketing. Lewis is from Waupaca, Wisconsin.
