### **Department of Education Eliminating PIN**

Approximately May 10, 2015, the U. S. Department of Education will be replacing the Federal Student Aid (FSA) PIN number with a modernized ID login process to improve security and the customer experience for their student and borrower based websites. Websites affected are fafsa.ed.gov, nslds.ed.gov, StudentLoans.gov, and StudentAid.gov.

The new FSA ID will be comprised of a user-selected username and password and will replace the PIN as the process by which students, parents and borrowers authenticate their identity to access their federal student aid information.

When accessing any of the above websites for the first time after May 10, 2015, users will be asked to create their new FSA ID. Those who already have a FSA PIN, will be able to access the site immediately while those without a PIN will be required to wait several days while their identity is verified through the Social Security Administration.

### Are You Transferring From UW-L?

If you are planning to transfer from the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse to another institution, please do the following:

- Contact the UW-L Financial Aid Office to inform us that you're transferring from UW-L
- If you have a Perkins Loan, contact the UW-L Cashier's Office to inform them of your intent to transfer
- If you borrowed federal loans while you were at UW-L, complete the federally required Exit Loan Counseling (at <a href="https://www.studentloans.gov">www.studentloans.gov</a>).
- Remove the UW-L school code (003919) from your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

### **Ask Earnest**

"Dear Earnest, Am I required to complete Exit Loan Counseling? Exit Loan Counseling must be completed each time that a student drops below half-time, leaves school or graduates. The counseling is still required even if you are transferring to another school or going on to graduate school.

Completing the required Exit Loan Counseling (at <a href="www.studentloans.gov">www.studentloans.gov</a>) does not cause your loans to go into repayment. It is used as a data gathering tool for the loan servicer who will be working with you when you do enter repayment on your federal student loans.
