Students wishing to minor in German Studies are not required to have a work/study experience broad, but are strongly encouraged to do so. This is especially true for students who have never spent more than a month in a German-speaking country. Students who might want to include such an experience in their undergraduate program may receive academic credit in German for their work.

Recommend programs include:

- An academic year in Oldenburg, or
- An academic semester in Oldenburg, or
- The summer program in Hessen

Students may receive 66 per cent of the required 18 credits in the German Studies Minor through foreign work/study experience. Students are required to complete at least one course at the University of Wisconsin - La Crosse upon return from their overseas experience. Students may petition the Department of Modern Languages to be excused from taking a course when they return.
