Please Note:

At UW-L it is possible to pursue a minor in **International Studies with a Latin American emphasis**. Study Abroad Prerequisite and Credit

Spanish minors need to complete SPA 303 at UWL prior to studying abroad. It is strongly recommended that SPA 304 also be completed before studying abroad.

A student pursuing a minor in Spanish at the University of Wisconsin - La Crosse may earn up to 66% of the credit hours for the minor in a foreign country. Thirty-four per cent of the credit hours must be earned at UW-L.

Students returning from study abroad must complete one three-credit Spanish course at UW-L. A student has the right to petition this policy. In this event the Chair of the Department of Modern Languages shall appoint a committee to evaluate the case in terms of the following criteria:

1. Proficiency examination (oral and written), and
2. Evaluation of the student's performance prior to the study experience in the foreign country.

The committee shall submit its findings to the department chair who in turn will report to the student concerned.
