*French 303 & 304 should be taken in sequence as soon as possible after 202. Other 300-level courses may be taken concurrently with 303 and 304.

Foreign Study & Credit for the French Minor

A student pursuing a minor in French at the University of Wisconsin - La Crosse may earn up to 66% of the credit hours for the minor requirement in a foreign country. Thirty-four per cent of the credit hours must be earned at UW-L. The student is required to take at least one course in French at UW-L after returning from the country of study.

A student has the right to petition this policy. In this event, the Chair of the Department shall appoint a committee to evaluate the case in terms of the following criteria:

1. Proficiency examinations (oral and written)
2. Evaluation of the student's performance prior to the study experience in the foreign country.

The committee shall submit its findings to the Department Chair who will in turn report to the student concerned.
