

PSYCHOLOGY MAJORS - CREDITS & DECISION POINTS (as of Spring 2011)

ALL UW-L STUDENTS NEED 120 CREDITS TO GRADUATE

40 credits at the 300/400 level

General Education
(39 min credits in required categories + additional to reach 48-49 credits)

College of Liberal Studies (CLS) BS or BA requirements
(see below) + credits to reach 120

CLS requirements - Choose a Major in CLS

CLS Degree Program - CHOOSE one of three Bachelor of Arts (BA) options or the BS option

*Students majoring in English or in a Modern Language must earn a Bachelor of Arts degree.

BA - Fine Arts

BA - Humanities

BA - Language

BS - Bachelor of Science

- One modern language course 102 or higher

OR

- an OIE approved semester long study abroad experience along with the INS 250, 251, 252 sequence

+

- 2 additional courses outside your major department from least two different depts chosen from: Art, Communication Studies, Music, Theatre
- One additional course in social sciences or humanities

- One modern language course 102 or higher

OR

- an OIE approved semester long study abroad experience along with the INS 250, 251, 252 sequence

+

- 2 additional courses outside your major department from least two different depts chosen from: History, English, Philosophy.
- One additional course in social sciences or fine arts

- Complete CHI202 or FRE 202 or GER 202 or RUS202 or SPA 202 or MLG 202 or MLG 304 or ESL proficiency score of 80 or above.*
- Two additional courses outside your major in humanities, social sciences OR fine arts.

NOTE:

- At least one course in your College Degree Program must be a CLS designated diversity course.
- All courses are in addition to the minimum 39 credits required in the General Education Program.
- Applicable courses may also be found on the *CLS BA/BS Degree Option Course List*.

Complete 4 courses outside your major department:

- A lab science course (from the Gen Ed list)
- A social science course
- An additional social science, Gen Ed natural science, math or approved CLS alternative
- One additional course in humanities or fine arts or complete a modern language course 102 or higher.

CLS Degree Program – choose a minor, 2nd major OR the “program option”

MINOR (in any college)

(usually 20+ credits)

- in the catalog look under the departmental listings
- some minors have slightly different requirements if you are a CLS student

PROGRAM OPTION - 18 credits

- 12 of which must be at the 300/400 level
- All credits outside of your major
- at least two different depts need to be represented (from any college)
