## A Data Analyst's Life

Alumni Mashele Huschka, Jeff Smith, and Jason Wampfler talk about working at Mayo

The Division of Biostatistics at the Mayo Clinic has provided consultation on statistical design and analysis for the clinical and laboratory research staff at Mayo since this service was introduced in 1932. The Biostatistics Division in Rochester is currently staffed with over 130 statisticians (25 Lead/PhD, 46 M.S., 65 B.S.), as well as additional programming and support staff. The 65 B.S. level statisticians, also known as Data Analysts, perform many duties, including creating data collection forms, designing databases, ensuring data integrity, analyzing data, interpreting and presenting results, and coauthoring manuscripts. This presentation will demonstrate how a Data Analyst utilizes statistical knowledge and programming skills to accomplish all these tasks.
