

Accessing Wireless Network Using Pre Shared Key

Requirements:

- Windows XP or Vista
- Wireless Network Card
- Predetermined SSID and passphrase to access network.
- If your network card does not support WPA-PSK, you may need to update your wireless card drivers. Launch Windows Update and select *Hardware, Optional* from the left hand side once the scan is complete.

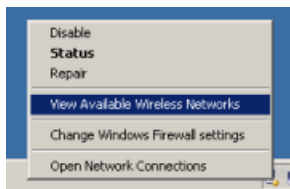
Network SSID: UWLGuest

Open the Wireless Network Connections Window
Right click on the Wireless Networking icon in the system tray.

Select *View Available Wireless Networks*

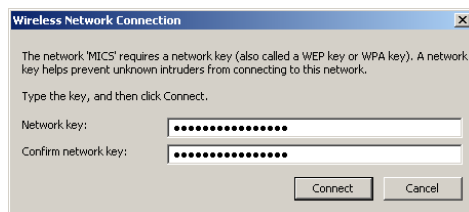


Choose the network listed above.

Enter the passphrase and confirm. Click *Connect*.



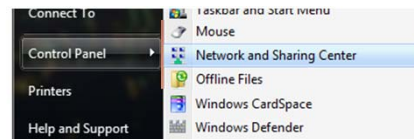
Network Key: NCUR2009!

Tips:

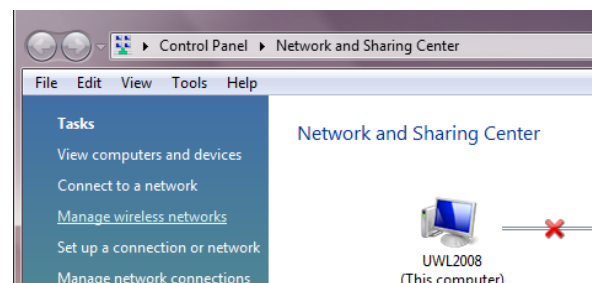
- Make sure your computer's wireless card is turned on.

Windows Vista

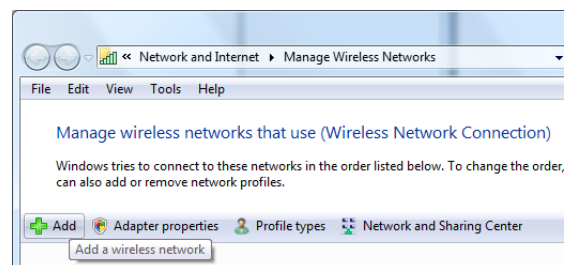
Open the Network and Sharing Center
