## **PeopleSoft Student Information System (SIS) Project Update**

Student Information System (SIS) Project Teams have been working this summer to set up and configure the PeopleSoft Campus Solutions software that will replace current legacy systems, including CAS, Admissions, TALON and AERIE).

Admissions will go live in September and will begin accepting applications for new students enrolling for summer and fall 2009. The project timeline provides for all modules, including Financial Aid, Student Records, Student Financials, and Academic Advising, to be live by fall 2009.

The legacy systems will continue to be used in the 2008-09 school year. Data will be converted or maintained as appropriate in both systems during the transition.

Highlights from the implementation teams include:  
Projects completed:

- New hardware has been installed, configured and tested; performance testing is on-going.
- Set-up for Recruiting and Admissions, Financial Aid, Student Financials, and Student Records is on track
- The Academic Advising Team started July 14 and set-up for degree audit is underway.
- Student data back to 1986 and course data back to 1965 have been converted enabling transcript processing for alumni.
- Nearly 45,000 high schools and over 4,000 colleges have been added to the database.
- Over 10,500 prospective students and more than 85,500 student bio demo records have been converted.
- Initial planning with Human Resources and other campus offices has taken place to define the personnel data used in business processes that will be converted to PeopleSoft Campus Solutions.

Projects on deck:

- Continued modeling and testing of the Recruiting and Admissions module.
- End-user training on the Recruiting and Admissions module.
- Continued data verification as records are converted from legacy.
- Campus review sessions.
- Load balancing testing.
- 43,000 rows of transfer course equivalences will be verified and converted.
- Course pre- and co-requisites will be added to the enrollment engine.
