Moratorium on CAS, TALON, AERIE, and Admissions Systems

UW-L will soon begin the transition process from its current legacy student information system to the PeopleSoft Campus Solutions environment. The new software will provide students, faculty, and staff with access to information related to recruiting and admissions, records and registration, academic advising, financial aid, student financials, and enhanced self-service capabilities.

An implementation partner will soon be hired to assist the campus with work starting in February 2008. A phased implementation is planned to coincide with normal business processes/cycles. The current Admissions system will be the first system replaced with a Campus Solutions module with a Fall of 2008 go-live date; full implementation is to be completed by the fall of 2009. The current systems (CAS, TALON, and AERIE) will continue to run during the PeopleSoft Campus Solutions implementation process; however there will be a moratorium on any changes to current systems. Changes mandated by federal and/or state government or UW System will be reviewed and prioritized. If you should have such a request, please contact the ITS Support Center to begin the review process.

The next 18 months will require significant work on the part of many dedicated staff in Admissions, Records, Financial Aid, Business Services, and Information Technology Services. We ask your patience and understanding during this time of transition. Key staff members from each of the above areas are leading the implementation work for their respective unit; as a result, questions may be referred to other staff during this transition. We are confident that the many talented employees at UW-L and their commitment to the students and customer service will lead this project to a successful completion.
