WHY OFFICIATE?

The Recreational Sports Department helps develop valuable skills. Our staff members are provided quality hands-on experiences which develop skills in areas such as conflict resolution, team building, time management, communication and leadership in a fun and exciting atmosphere!

During the clinics, a variety of instructional methods will be employed. These include training videos, rule interpretation discussions, and skill training stations. The final session of training clinics includes an actual hands-on field/court experience under close supervision of our professional staff, graduate assistants, and undergraduate supervisors.

WHAT DOES IT TAKE?

Officials should have a genuine love for sports, some working knowledge of the game, the ability to assume leadership and responsibility, the willingness to devote the time and effort necessary to become the best official and the commitment to improve one's skills. Each official starts at a base salary with possible raises for each successive year of service.

JOIN A WINNING TEAM!

Intramural officials play a significant role in the success of the Recreational Sports Department. They're our front line staff who interact directly with our intramural participants. Without quality, hard working officials
