### School of Education Scholarship

A \$200 scholarship for School of Education students will be awarded in exchange for completing a service plan to promote cultural competence in education.

Students may apply using one of the three options available:

OPTION #1: Plan and deliver a presentation to the School of Education faculty on teaching and learning at Fowler School District. This would be a 15-30 minute group presentation with your colleagues who attend with you.

Option #2: Write a newsletter article for Teacher Talk, the UW-L School of Education newsletter.

Option #3: Develop your own plan to execute your responsibilities. Include what you plan to do and who your audience will be.
