A member of The Society of Authors since 1987 Doreen has had over 20 books published about Irish Folklore in Ireland and beyond by Longmans, Poolbeg Press, Adare Press, BQ Publications, various local teachers' Centers and The Ulster Folk and Transport Museum.

Doreen is an international storyteller/ writer. She has performed her researched work in UK, throughout Ireland, in Canada, New Zealand and toured U.S.A. coast to coast. A featured storyteller at many festivals and conferences at home and abroad, Doreen has undertaken temporary posts such as storyteller/writer in residence and organized writer and storyteller workshops at home and abroad.

Doreen has written 3 plays for children broadcast cast in the series 'Today and Yesterday' on B.B.C. School Radio, has had 6 short stories broadcast on BBC Radio Ulster, been the subject of Numerous T.V. and radio programs in Ireland and a documentary broadcast of EVT South Carolina which was used by the Sumpter Campus of South Carolina in their storytelling programmes.
