

Greg Mortenson Live Stream

On the morning of Tuesday, September 29th, Greg Mortenson will speak live at Viterbo University in La Crosse, Wisconsin between 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. WKBT.com will provide a live video stream of the presentation on their website that day. To ensure that you will be able to view the live stream, take note of the steps you will need to take in order to find the live stream and the computer requirements you will need on the day of the presentation.

Steps to Find the Live Stream

- 1) Go to WKBT.com the morning of September 29th.
- 2) Click on the Breaking News story titled "Live Streaming – Greg Mortenson "Pennies for Peace" – 10:00 a.m."



- 3) You can also reach the same page by going to, <http://www.wkbt.com/LIVE>.
- 4) If the live stream video player displays correctly on the page, you will see an image that says, "If you can see this image, the live stream will work for this computer." If you do not see the video player, check the requirements below.

Live Stream Computer Requirements

Web Browser

- Livestream is Web-based, so it will work on most Web browsers running on most operating systems (including Windows and Mac OSX).
- The Adobe Flash Player plugin is required. You can download the most recent plugin at, <http://www.adobe.com/flashplatform>.

Internet Connection

- To view Livestream content, we recommend a minimum of 500kbps of download speed.
- You can use this speed test (or any other popular bandwidth tester) to test your Internet connection at this link, <http://www.speedtest.net>.

No Installation

- No installation is required, except your favorite Internet browser and the latest Adobe Flash player. Otherwise, you're ready to Livestream!

Test Your Computer

On Friday, September 25th between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. the live stream page and player will be posted through WKBT.com's homepage (or by going to <http://www.wkbt.com/LIVE>) for users to test the live stream player on their computers. If the live stream player is working properly on your computer, you will see a graphic saying, "If you can see this image, the live stream will work for this computer." Computer requirement instructions will also be display on the page that day for troubleshooting. The same "Working Correctly" image will be displayed on the live stream player the morning of the presentation.

Back Up Live Stream Players

If you are unable to open the player on the test day or the presentation day, there will be a couple back up pages that will also display the live stream. In the instance that the page cannot be displayed, there will be a link to a Windows Media Live Stream player at the top of the initial live stream page and within WKBT.com's homepage Breaking News box.

You may also try <http://www.livestream.com/WKBT> if you cannot view the other players. The requirements for this player are the same as the initial player on <http://www.wkbt.com/LIVE>.
