Foundation Assets

- ◆ **Endowment funds of \$14.8 million** provide income for 345 scholarship programs and 53 multipurpose programs for departmental research, program support and professional development programs.
- ◆ The UW-L Foundation also manages **254 restricted funds**, which provide operating support for various departments and programs. The current balance of restricted funds is **\$2.5 million**.
- ◆ The UW-L Foundation also has **\$223,000 in unrestricted funds** to be used for foundation and university priorities to enhance UW-L's margin of excellence.



Employment/Payroll

- ◆ UW-La Crosse employs more than 965 people with an estimated **payroll of more than \$76.8 million per year**.
- ◆ **Health insurance premiums** for UW-L employees, including employee and employer contributions, are estimated to be **\$11.9 million per year**.

- ◆ Students represent 43 states and 282 international students from 45 countries.
- ◆ Ethnic minority enrollment hit a record of nearly six percent of the student body in Fall 2007.
- ◆ Sixty-five percent of the students attending UW-L receive financial aid.
- ◆ More than 575 students received scholarships worth over \$573,000 for the 2007-08 academic year.
- ◆ Eleven residence halls house more than 3,100 students.
- ◆ Eighty-eight undergraduate programs and emphases in 44 disciplines; 26 graduate programs and emphases in nine disciplines.

Information as of Fall 2007

Local Purchases

- ◆ UW-L made over **\$9.1 million** worth of local purchases from July 1, 2006 to June 30, 2007.
- ◆ UW-L did business with more than **400 local vendors** in fiscal year 2006.
- ◆ **Several local vendors were each paid more than \$40,000** during the 2006-07 fiscal year. These companies provided food service, transportation, healthcare, building and remodeling services, and more.

City Municipal Services

- ◆ During fiscal year 2006-07, **more than \$1 million was paid to the City of La Crosse** for UW-La Crosse's waste removal, police and fire protection.
