Pianist Dave Marck has resided in New York City for 45 years. In addition to his jazz piano performances Dave spent nearly 30 years working for Jacque D'Amboise's National Dance Institute. He has also worked as an accompanist for the New York University's New School of Jazz and Contemporary Music program. He has also accompanied entertainers Joan Rivers and Cloris Leachman as well as Broadway stars Charolette D'Amboise, Terrence Mann and Tony Yazbeck.
