- Approval of Minutes 4<sup>th</sup> Meeting March 31<sup>st</sup> 2016 – 6App
- ECO 230: Instructors are interested in updating curriculum. Solicited names for faculty across the college to consult in ongoing process.
- Discussion of Math requirements/quantitative literacy
  - Require all students to take MTH 150 regardless of placement then each department develops its own quantitative literacy LO.
  - Introduce a new course analogous to ENG 112 for students who test out of MTH 150 and require it to reinforce college algebra skills.
  - Require all students to have MTH 150, MTH 175 and STAT 145 with C or better before admitting and have CBA LO in quantitative literacy.
- Teamwork Skills
  - We are already doing team projects
  - Do we teach team skills? Doing team projects is not the same as learning team skills.
  - Models for assessment exist – some hinging on CATME tool which many faculty already use.
  - Add to charge for next year.
