Details

Several **\$4,000** fellowships will be awarded to undergraduates for <u>summer research projects</u>. Applications can be found at the URL listed below or using the QR code.

Purpose

To foster collaborative research between an undergraduate student and her/his faculty mentor. This program encourages students to participate in a range of scientific experiences, including project design and implementation, analysis and summary of results, and professional communication of findings.

Eligibility

Any student with a declared major in a College of Science and Health program. Applicants must be in good academic standing (GPA at least 3.0 both overall and in the major), have successfully completed 30 credit hours of coursework <u>at UW-L</u>, and have <u>at least one semester remaining</u> <u>before graduation</u>. Research associated with this fellowship requires close collaboration between the student and sponsoring faculty mentor.

Time required

Students will be expected to work on their projects for at least 30 hours per week over a 10-week period during the summer (starting approximately mid June).

Credits

Students must enroll for one (1) credit of research during the summer (e.g. BIO 499, CHM 499, CS 499, GEO/ESC 499, MIC 499, MTH 499, NMT 499, OT 499, HED 495, ESS 324 or PHY 498).
