- *Passing scores on Praxis II tests for the appropriate certification area/discipline **or** ACTFL Oral and Written Proficiency tests (French, German, Spanish only)*.*

Additional Testing/Portfolio Requirements for EC-A Program Completion

Basic Skills Competencies: Teacher candidates must earn a grade of "C" or better in the following courses in order to demonstrate Basic Skills competency : CST 110, ENG 110, and MTH courses that satisfy GE02.

Praxis II (Subject) Content Knowledge Test: A passing score must be on file in 260 Morris Hall BEFORE the student teaching semester begins. Register to test at www.ets.org/praxis. Teacher candidates are encouraged to take the Praxis II test before the Field II block. **OR**

American Council Teaching of Foreign Languages score report demonstrating oral and written proficiency with a rating of "Intermediate High" in French, German, and/or Spanish (ONLY required for French education, German education or Spanish education candidates).

Teacher Education Portfolio: Candidates must complete two (2) portfolio benchmark assessments to complete their program. The Pre-student Teaching Benchmark occurs during the Field II semester. The Post-Student Teaching Benchmark occurs during the student teaching semester and includes the edTPA.
