Foundations of Reading Test: A minimum score of 240 on the Wisconsin Foundations of Reading Test must be on file in with the School of Education before the student teaching semester begins. Register to test at <a href="http://www.wi.nesinc.com/">http://www.wi.nesinc.com/</a>. Teacher candidates are encouraged to take the FoRT test immediately after completion of the Field I block.

Praxis II Middle School Content Test: Take test #5146 after admission to teacher education. A minimum score of 146 must be on file with the School of Education before the student teaching semester begins. Register to test at www.ets.org/praxis. Additional content testing may be required, depending on the minor selected. Teacher candidates are encouraged to take the FoRT test before the Field II block.

Teacher Education Portfolio: Candidates must complete two (2) portfolio benchmark assessments to complete their program. The Pre-student Teaching Benchmark occurs during the Field II semester and includes portions of the edTPA. The Post-Student Teaching Benchmark occurs during the student teaching semester and includes the edTPA.
