HOW TO SUBMIT TO THE UWL COLLEGE WRITING SYMPOSIUM

We have designed an open call for proposals to encourage as many students as possible to participate in this year's symposium--proposals on any topic and in any genre will be accepted.

Submission Guidelines: Students should submit a title and a brief proposal of 100 words or fewer by **Monday, November 11th**. The format of the symposium will be one-hour concurrent sessions. Students should budget presentations for approximately 10-15 minutes per presenter.
