Considerations:

- Spanish 300 should count toward one of the oral proficiency courses.
- 326 Current Events (1 credit) will no longer be offered. Students from a previous catalogue will need to take an additional 3-credit course, at any level.
- The last catalogue year for the old program is Fall 2018. The cycle should largely be through by the fall semester of 2022.
- The current residency requirement states that students must take an upper-level literature course upon return from Study abroad. With all the new linguistics courses, we need to change this requirement.
- SPA 302 counts either as SPA 300 or SPA 321. It cannot be taken twice.

Considerations for Minors:

- Previous catalogue = 18 credits
