Each academic plan is unique, but the guidelines below will help you schedule the BA major required courses. **Notes:**

- IS-440 is only offered in Spring semesters
- Prerequisites are strictly enforced
- The possible schedules below are guides and do not account for all situations.
- The guide does not show the required CBA courses. Please refer to the CBA advising site for CBA requirements and work with your advisor on your academic plan.
- A standard goal is admission into the CBA by end of Sophomore Year or First semester Junior Year.
- Students interested in obtaining an internship and taking IS-451 as their elective, must satisfy all CBA internship prerequisites and receive approval from career services and the IS department.

- IS-451 = GPA > 2.50 → ACC-221, ACC-222, BLAW-205, ECO-110, ECO-120, ECO-230, FIN-355, IS-220, MGT-308, MKT-309; admission to business
