Standard Guidelines for MGT Internship Deliverables: Student Guide

This set of guidelines is intended to provide additional guidance for students receiving MGT 450 credit for internship experiences. Specifically, this guide provides expectations for internship deliverables.

Early Deliverable: Developmental Objectives

Prior to or in the early stages of the internship experience, the student should identify broad objectives and/or goals to be realized during the internship related to the students' development as a Management major.

These objectives may be submitted to the Management faculty advisor via email or during an initial meeting before or near the beginning of the internship experience.

Final Deliverable: Reflection Paper

The student's final deliverable for MGT 450 internship credit should take the form of a reflective paper, which includes (but is not necessarily limited to) the student's thoughts and reflection on the following:

- The student's goals for internship, connected to the goals/objectives determined prior to the internship and reflection on how/to what extent the goals/objectives were met
- Perceived linkage to CBA and Management department learning outcomes, available here for CBA: https://www.uwlax.edu/cba/undergraduate-curriculum-learning-goals-and-objectives2/#tm-common-course-learning-objectives); and here for Management: http://catalog.uwlax.edu/undergraduate/management/managementbs/
- Summary of what the student did during the internship experience (may or may not include activity log)
- More in-depth report out on a project or specific task/set of tasks completed (option to include a sample of project outcome, e.g., presentation or professional report)
- Network the student built, and/or is building
- Skills learned and evaluation of self-development
- How student's coursework in Management has enhanced the internship experience and, based on internship experience, any perceived gaps in the Management curriculum or general feedback on the Management curriculum

Expectations for formatting and grading are as follows:

- I. Length of deliverable should be approximately 5 single-spaced pages.
- II. Grade determination: MGT 450 is a Pass/Fail course, thus assuming students submitted the deliverable within the parameters set, they would earn a "P" for the internship.

^{*}Starting Spring of 2020, all students earning MGT 450 credit for internship experiences should submit their final internship deliverable (reflection paper) to the MGT 450 Canvas assignment.
