### Program Benefits

- Experience the increased academic rigor and pace of a university course.
- Learn from teachers at their high school.
- Gain credit from UW System's top ranked public comprehensive campus while fulfilling high school requirements.

### Tuition

- The tuition for UWL Concurrent Enrollment courses is \$110 per credit.
- Students are responsible for Concurrent Enrollment (CE) tuition; however, many schools subsidize some or all the tuition. Partner districts notify students and families of the cost of tuition and if any payment is due to the school.

### Student Eligibility

- High school junior or senior. 3.25 GPA or higher; students with GPA of 3.0-3.24 will be considered if space is available. Completion of any prerequisite courses.
- Passing placement test scores for ENG 110 and SPA 307.

### Grades

- Students' grades in a UWL CE course are part of their permanent academic record.
- Earn college credit that may be [transferred](#) to other colleges & universities.
