

## Concurrent Enrollment in Your Academic and Career Planning

### BENEFITS OF CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT COURSES:

- Experience increased academic rigor and college-level expectations.
- Take college courses in your school with familiar teachers.
- Get a jump on your general education requirements before starting college.

### HOW STUDENTS GET STARTED:

Ask your school counselor if there are UWL concurrent enrollment opportunities at your school and if you are eligible to participate:

- If yes, talk to your family about your interest in concurrent enrollment and ask your school counselor to help you complete the application materials required to enroll in the program.

### INTERESTED STUDENTS MUST MEET UW-LA CROSSE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- High school junior or senior at time of course:
  - Seniors must rank in upper 25% of their class **OR** have a composite score of 26 or greater on the ACT test
  - Juniors must rank in upper 10% of their class
- Successful completion of appropriate preparation for concurrent enrollment program, including high school course work and passing score on Wisconsin placement tests, if relevant
- Submission of all required admission materials by UWL deadlines
