

Research, Service, and Educational Leadership (RSEL) – MINI GRANT TIP SHEET

This information is available for student/faculty reference on the Graduate Studies website. The information should be used as a guide when applying for RSEL Grants. While not all inclusive, this list identifies common reasons for application rejection or funding reduction. It is important to note the importance of maintaining professional standards in application completion.

APPLICATION DIFFICENCY	POTENTIAL RESULT
Objectives of the project are not clearly identified.	Funding denied
No explanation of how data will be synthesized and presented.	Funding denied
Missing statement of assurance from faculty advisor.	Funding denied
Failure to explain the distinct research component of research involving international travel. Lack of substantiation that travel is necessary to conduct the research.	Funding denied
Failure to explain the distinction between a research project and internship experience (internships/preceptorships are not fundable, but research completed during this capstone experience may be).	Funding denied
Failure to check appropriate boxes when IRB, IACUC, and/or IBC approval is needed (or to provide explication when approval is unnecessary).	Funding denied
Weak or overly general budget justification (in both budget sheet or narrative).	Funding reduction
Failure to write to general audience (i.e., too much reliance on discipline-related jargon, failure to define key discipline-related terms).	Funding reduction
Lack of headings (i.e., Statement of Purpose, Objects, Final Product, etc.).	Funding reduction
Missing or limited citations of related research.	Funding reduction
Incorrect or inconsistent referencing.	Funding reduction
Poorly worded research question or purpose of study.	Funding reduction
Non-descriptive (boilerplate) faculty letter of support.	Funding reduction
Failure to agree to present at UWL Celebration of Research and Creativity (if student is unable to present during the April Celebration of Research and Creativity following completion of project, the student must present research/project proposal/preliminary results during the previous year's celebration of research.)	Funding reduction
