In order to establish and maintain a clinical site affiliation with the University of Wisconsin – La Crosse Medical Dosimetry Program the following are required of the clinical site:

Staff Requirements

- Board certified Radiation Oncologist(s)
- Board certified Medical Physicist(s)
- Board certified Medical Dosimetrist(s)
- at least one certified Medical Dosimetrist must be on-site at all times

Equipment

- Dual-energy linear accelerator with electron capabilities
- CT Simulator
- Treatment Planning System(s) with modern hardware and software to include image fusion, photon, electron and IMRT/VMAT/SBRT calculation capabilities
- Ion chamber and other calibration equipment (including in-vivo)

Brachytherapy planning services

Student-designated treatment planning workstation

Accessible computer with internet

Facility accreditation:

- TJC or DNV (hospital); or
- ACR or APEX (department); or
- state agency (private practice)
