Occupational Therapy Program Process Advising

- Faculty are assigned advisees each summer by program director. Consideration is given to making advising loads similar across all faculty.
- Students are oriented to the advising process during initial orientation to the program and in OT 572 (Fall 1)
- 3. The primary purpose of advising is to help the student develop appropriate professional behaviors and to be socialized into the occupational therapy profession.
- 4. Faculty meet with assigned students a minimum of once per semester.
- 5. Faculty use advising policy as talking point guide for discussions during each semester (see attached)
- 6. Fieldwork I evaluations will be available for faculty to review and discuss with students 3 weeks after the completion of each Fieldwork I course.
- 7. Faculty record discussions with advisee and file in student advising file within a week after the advising session is held.
- 8. Faculty will consult with program director if difficult issues arise with student
- 9. If student needs further advising on a specific issue, the process is turned over to the program director. Advisor may be asked to attend meetings with student and program director.
