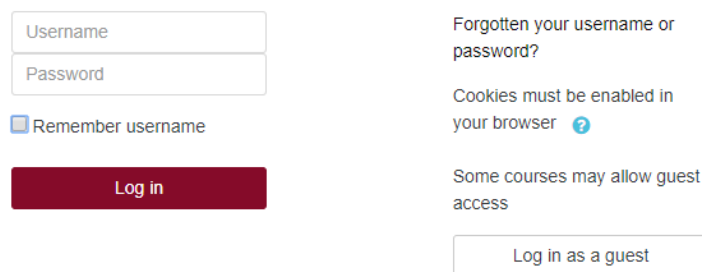


The University of Wisconsin - La Crosse requires applicants to complete an online asynchronous interview process. All interviews are conducted using a video-based platform called YouSeeU Bongo where students record their responses to a series of interview questions for review by the program's Admissions Committee. **The deadline for completing this for early admission is August 15. The deadline for completing for general admission is November 1.**

Students must have a computer with webcam and internet service to complete this interview. Please follow this link to the University of Wisconsin La Crosse Application Registration page <https://uwlax-admissions.youseeu.com/login> and follow these steps to enroll and complete the video interview:

1. Click "create new account" and register your email and personal information. This will send a link to your inbox that you will need to click to confirm your registration.
