- Submit UW Application and transcripts at <http://apply.wisconsin.edu> (no need to upload resume or essay to UW app)
- Submit Resume, personal statement, contacts for references, and this program application to Applicant Dashboard.
- You will receive an email invitation to the Applicant Dashboard within a few days of submitting your UW application. In order to meet the February 1 priority deadline, **we suggest you submit the UW Application a week earlier**, to ensure adequate time to gain access to the Applicant Dashboard. Reference contacts will be invited to upload letter, due Mar 1

February 17, 2022 - UWL SAA Virtual Visit Day

- We hope to host all selected candidates during our Virtual Visit Day on Thursday, Feb 17 from 11a-2p (central time) but will work with those who cannot make that day/time as best we're able.
- At Virtual Visit, candidates will also confirm graduate assistant/intern interviews that will occur virtually from Feb 21-Mar 11.

March 18, 2022 – Offers sent to students, with a request to accept or decline by April 15.

- Online coursework begins May 23; Campus-based hybrid coursework begins September 6.
- We continue to accept applications and conduct virtual interviews until all spots are filled.
