February 1, 2026 - Priority consideration deadline

- Submit UW Application and transcripts at http://apply.wisconsin.edu (no need to upload resume or essay to UW app)
- Submit Resume, personal statement, contacts for references, and this program application to Applicant Dashboard.
- You will receive an email invitation to the Applicant Dashboard within a few days of submitting your UW application. In order to meet the February 1 priority deadline, we suggest you submit the UW Application by January 25, to ensure adequate time to gain access to the Applicant Dashboard. Reference contacts will be invited to upload letter, due no later than Mar 1.

March 13, 2026 - Offers sent to students, with a request to accept or decline by March 30 for summer, April 15 for fall.

- Online coursework begins late May.
- We continue to accept applications and conduct virtual interviews until all spots are filled.

More information to come about the interview process SAA requires 600 hours of supervised practice while enrolled in the two-year program.
