## Please give a brief overview of the proposed items or project(s) you are requesting funding. What would be the approximate cost?

**This \$2,781 Green Fund request** will fund replacement of 32 watt 4-foot fluorescent lamps with 25 watt 4-foot fluorescent lamps in Roger Harring Stadium. The project will replace and recycle approximately 400 fluorescent lamps. All 4-foot fluorescent lamps will be replaced throughout the facility.


## What is the general timeline for the project? (When do you see this being on campus?)

The project will commence upon funding approval and be completed by the end of May 2016.

Please give a detailed explanation on the environmental impact of proposed project? Will this project reduce UW-Ls Carbon Foot print, water usage or electricity consumption? If indirectly please explain how.

This project will reduce electrical consumption from operating 4 foot fluorescent lamps by 20%. Lowered electrical consumption will reduce emissions resulting from burning of fossil fuels to create electricity. Reduced burning of fossil fuels will lower UWL's carbon footprint.
How will this project increase student understanding of environmental issues or actions?  This conversion to lower wattage fluorescent lamps in all UWL buildings is promoted by Escilities Planning and Management as one of the many energy soving.
