 - 1. Nielsen: Yes
 - ii. Woodmansee: Clarification of binding vs nonbinding?
 - 1. Jurecki: *Explains how binding vs nonbinding works*

 - 1. Jurecki: It was not necessary and allows more discussion due to the quick timeline.
 - iv. Becker: I agree with this resolution and think it should pass.
 - v. McCauley: Do we need to suspend the 2-week rule?
 - vi. Neader: Do we want yearly operational cost to be included in the resolution?
 - 1. Woodmansee: Maybe we should lean to include operation costs to be included as it is what seg fees will cover.
 - 2. Schock: *Clarification of seg fee use*
 - vii. Silva: *Inquires into how they are funding it to reach ground breaking in two vears*
 - 1. Jurecki: *Explains how bonding will be used to fund the dome*
 - viii. Becker: The university is contributing a substantial amount to the dome.
 - ix. Thering: I'm concerned about the length of the referendum language and am considering prioritizing information of referendum language?
 - 1. Soeder: We could change the structure and put the seg fee change as its own bullet point and move it to the top of the referendum in the language.
 - x. Jurecki: *Informally garners information on bullet point usage*
 - xi. McCauley: I feel like people will skim and focus on the bottom point
 - xii. Soeder: I move to put the costs to the top of the document/Lichtfuss
 - 1. Thering: I move to add seg fee costs/Nielsen
 - a. Lichtfuss: I supports the original verbiage of the document



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- b. Epps-Cool: It is all about money, but it separates how we pay for the dome and what exactly our seg fee does
- c. Silva: Call to question
 - i. Failed
- 2. Lasee: Call to question
 - a. Passed
- xiii. Silva: I don't know how high 65 ft is? *I move to remove the dimensions of the dome in the referendum language/Neilsen*
 - 1. Silva motions to remove dimensions of dome in referendum language
 - a. McClain: Dimensions may be needed to show how it may affect the bluffs.
 - b. McCauley: It is important to note how big it is
 - c. Neader: I move to remove only the length and width of the dome/ Thering
 - i. Schock: It is important to give information.
 - ii. Cayo: We asked so it is reasonable to assume they want it too.
 - iii. Bucheger: Do we possibly want to add that it doesn't cover track?
 - iv. Failed
 - d. Failed
- xiv. Epps-Cool: I think this is redundant, *I move to replace the 2nd bullet point with* "the dome doesn't cover the track"/Wears
 - 1. Neilsen: If we're concerned on length we could simply parenthetically note this in the opening paragraph? *I move to strike the motioned bullet point and parenthetically add "not including track"*/*Thering*
 - a. Epps-Cool: bullet points are where many will skip to thus this info is needed
 - i. Passed
 - 2. Epps-Cool: I would like to rescind my motion
- xv. Neilsen: Due to low turnout rate, it reduces how much we should be bound by it.
 - 1. Epps-Cool: Due to a split vote non-binding may be better
